Riesling [REEZ-ling] – is considered to be one of the world's great white-wine grapes and produces of the very best white wines. It's a native of Germany where it's believed to have been cultivated for at least 500 years, possibly for as long as 2000 years. This grapes balance of good acid and high sugar levels produces wine with considerable aging potential. The delicate but complex Riesling wines are characterized by a spicy, fruity flavor reminiscent of peaches and apricots. Riesling is vinified in a variety of styles ranging from dry to very sweet.
